- NORCAP is supporting AMHEWAS to deliver on:
  - Management of the programme
  - -Capacity for detection, monitoring, analysis, and forecasting;
- Two experts Deployed at the AUC:
  - AMHEWAS programme Manager & Drought Risk Assessment Expert; and
- DRR Expert at the ICPAC situation Room linked to the Pan African situation Room at AUC.
- Joint efforts to collaboratively mobilise resources to support operationalization of the programme are ongoing




## SUPPORT TO RCCs

### Regional Hazard Watch and Continental Drought Advisory system

- NORCAP collaborated with ICPAC in developing the East Africa Hazards Watch
- The system tracks extreme events, aggregates risk data from different sources and provides improved risk information
- The system has registered 18,200 users since it was rolled out last year (2022).
- Under a joint initiative with btw ACMAD and EU Joint Research Centre, NORCAP is supporting development of African Drought Advisory System.
- The system will contain relevant drought information and allow users to interactively visualize drought product and generate reports





- It adopts best practices in data visualization and hydro meteorological department and climate communications. All components of the website are built on free and open-source standards allowing for collaboration and contribution.

  - a customisable and modern design
  - seamless email marketing and event integrations
  - a user-friendly CAP editor
  - advanced climate data visualization tools for any NMHS seeking to upgrade its website
  - User analytics and Survey creation

The countries are being trained to adopt a user-friendly **Content Management System (CMS)** which contains modules for user friendly activation of **Common Alert Protocols (CAP) alerts**, **email marketing** and **user data management**.


So far **58 technical assistance meetings** have taken place, over **119 hours, and 81 people** were trained **as of 8th Nov 2023**. Technical assistance to countries is being supported by NORCAP.










## **Interactive Data Visualization**





NMHSs can upload and visualize inhouse products like **forecasts**, **warnings**, **advisories** etc.



Allows inclusion of Exposure data (Population, Infrastructure etc.) to support Impact based analysis
